





Front Text: "CRUX S. P. BENEDICTI", shows St. Benedict with a raven and a cup. Back Text: "V. R. S. N. S. M. V. S. M. Q. L. I. V. B." around rim. On Cross: "N. D. S. M. D. / C. S. S. M. H. L. / C. S.
