[^0]:    ${ }^{1}$ The first step in the tanning process was to wash and clean the hides in flowing water or surface vats filled with fresh water. After the rinsed hides are immersed in lime and water for a spell, they are placed in "bate" vats containing water, salt, and chicken or pigeon manure or potash to enlarge pores to receive tanning liquor. This process could be described as laying the hides down in salts. The word here looks like it could read "falls," but no waterfalls or even strong flowing water was available at the site, so it most likely reads "salts" in reference to the bating process.
